VOTING GUIDELINES

- 1. Every Canadian citizen should be mindful of his/her duty to promote the common good by exercising his/her right to vote. We must vote in a way that we hope will make our country better for all Canadians, using an informed conscience.
- 2. The most basic of all our rights is the right to life, the right from which all other rights flow. Vote for a pro-life candidate, which can be discerned by checking the pro-life voting record of an incumbent or by asking a candidate how he/she would vote on pro-life legislation.
- 3. If no strongly pro-life candidate exists, use the chart provided to determine which party/candidate is the least hostile to the right to life and to the family and to the common good of society.
- 4. A ballot marked "No Suitable Candidate" is rejected by Elections Canada no differently than a ballot rejected for being left blank or defaced. There is no way of knowing what the voter's intent was in failing to mark the ballot properly for one candidate.
- 5. Most important of all **don't forget to vote**!
