JUSTIN TRUDEAU'S ELITE WORLD

Justin Trudeau was born into wealth, and has spent his entire life fraternizing with the wealthy, powerful and influential. This has distanced and insulated him from the concerns of the less advantaged—namely, most of us.

As a result, he knows little and understands less about the lives of ordinary people. As long as he is with globalist billionaires, celebrities, diplomats and foreign politicians, he is in his element. The 35 million Canadian citizens do not appear to have Trudeau's interest, or even respect. For example, Trudeau regards only feminist women to be worthy of his interest, the rest of us are discarded.

During an interview with the New York Times, in 2015, Trudeau stated: "There is no core identity, no mainstream in Canada". In this bizarre statement, Trudeau is ignoring Canada's proud history of European national origins, our pan-cultural heritage and strong traditions. Instead, he is imposing on the country his own limited understanding of Canada and his own narrow vision.

HOMOSEXUAL SECRETARIAT IN PRIVY COUNCIL OFFICE

In the March, 2017 budget, Trudeau established a homosexual secretariat in the Privy Council Office, headed by

homosexual Liberal MP Randy Boissonnault (Edmonton Centre). Mr. Boissonnault's responsibilities include coordinating the machinery of government to advance homosexual rights. Boissonnault claims that his new role has already led to the recent Liberal decision to provide a federal tax credit for homosexuals to use reproductive technology to create children. Such children are only "objects" to satisfy homosexual couples. This has been done despite a mountain of evidence which shows that children require opposite-sex parents to grow up to be well-balanced individuals.

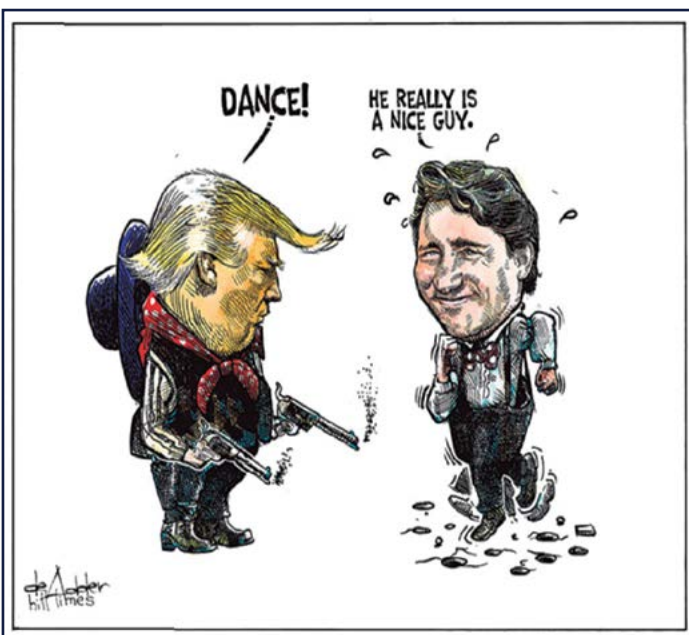
Boissonnault's job also includes working with LGBT organizations and the government to provide an apology to homosexuals for supposed past discrimination. He also plans to work behind the scenes at the Commonwealth meetings where 36 of 52 member nations do not accept the west's approach to homosexuality.

OVERT DISCRIMINATION AGAINST PRO-LIFE GROUPS

Trudeau has stopped summer job funding by Liberal MPs awarded to pro-life organizations. Last year Liberal MP Iqra Khalid (Mississauga-Erin Mills) had approved more than \$56,000 to the Canada Summer Job Program for the Calgary based Canadian Centre for Bioethical Reform. Pro-life groups, such as Campaign Life Coalition, LifeSiteNews, and Priests for Life also received a total of \$3.5 million in 2016. The Abortion Rights Coalition of Canada brought this terrible information to Trudeau's attention, who was scandalized by it, and has set about changing the rules for summer job programs, prohibiting any further funding to pro-life groups by Liberal MPs. Planned Parenthood, Ottawa, and Planned Parenthood, Toronto, were among groups that received Canada Summer Jobs grants in

the past and they, along with other pro-abortion groups, will be generously funded in the future. Narrow minded, bigoted and discriminatory are adjectives that come to mind when describing Justin Trudeau's perspective.

TRUDEAU PREFERS TRAVELLING TO GOVERNING

Because of Trudeau's elitism, he appears to have little interest in actually governing Canada. It's tedious and boring work. He doesn't like to cloud his mind with issues. As a result, since he has become Prime Minister, he has established some 80 "consultation" groups to come up with a plan of action on such diverse issues as, marijuana, senate appointments, appointments to the Supreme Court of Canada, economic policies, immigration, etc. These are not "public" consultations by any means, but are consultations led by liberal fellow travellers whom Trudeau disarmingly calls "independent and non-partisan". He employs (at taxpayer's expense) a photographer, Adam Scotti, who follows him around all day long taking flattering photographs of him which are then posted all over the media. Trudeau and his wife were prominent on Vogue fashion magazine in 2016. He was delighted to recently appear and make a speech at the Canadian Juno Awards with his wife Sophie Gregoire. He spent his Christmas holidays at the luxurious home of the Imam Aga Khan on the latter's Bahamian Island. The Aga Khan Foundation, not incidentally, has received \$300 million in funding from the federal government. Trudeau lied when he said he was required to take the Aga Khan's helicopter to the island (against government regulations), claiming that there was no other way to reach it. This was incorrect. This trip cost the Canadian taxpayers \$127,000 to cover the cost of security for the Prime Minister, including travel expenses, overtime wages and per diem for RCMP members. Further costs included \$32,000

for the use of the government's Challenger Jet and accommodation and per diem staff from Global Affairs Canada. Accompanying Trudeau and his family were the President of the Liberal Party of Canada and her husband, Trudeau's close friend, Tom Pitfield. The latter lucked out in receiving money from the Trudeau government to sponsor a conference that featured Liberal cabinet ministers as speakers. The Liberal party has also hired Tom Pitfield to train personnel for party purposes. Trudeau denies that Pitfield was hired because of cronyism. Rather, he claimed it was because of Pitfield's competence. Why would we think otherwise?

Trudeau still stubbornly refuses to stop his "cash for access" meetings with corporate, foreign and Canadian elites charging \$1,500 a plate. These meetings are attended by both Trudeau and many of his cabinet ministers. Some of these invitees to the meetings were high level Chinese investors, one of whom has agreed to fund the construction of a statue in Montreal, of Trudeau's father, at a cost of \$50,000. The Trudeau Foundation, also honouring Justin Trudeau's father, received a \$200,000 donation from this Chinese businessman and political advisor to the Chinese government.

Why is Trudeau continuing on his costly, narcissist track? It is because he believes that he is one of the "anointed" ones - one of the elites - who consider it their duty and responsibility to guide the benighted (ignorant) i.e. everyone else, away from their own worst instincts. He has a vision of himself as having a moral role in the world. Problems exist because others are not as wise or as virtuous as "the anointed".

Trudeau, believing he is above the ordinary, is a star in his own right. He thinks the show is all about him, and he thinks the optics of those opposing him are irrelevant because they are motivated by unworthy purposes. He is so immersed in the cult of himself as an international anointed celebrity that he does not realize he is not starring in a reality show, but is actually a Prime Minister elected to serve the public.

Unfortunately, Trudeau's gallivanting about does not mean that he has any influence. He has none at all. He is universally regarded as an intellectual light-weight with nothing to contribute, but his charm and good looks! His narcissism and vanity do not help Canada one little bit. †

DRUG INJECTION SITES KILL ADDICTS

The Liberal government proposes to solve the horrendous increase in drug overdose deaths by providing for the proliferation of drug injection sites. According to the testimony of Minister of Health, Jane Philpott, before the Senate Standing Committee on Legal and Constitutional Affairs, on March 29, 2017:

The evidence is abundant that when properly established and maintained supervised consumption sites save lives without increasing drug use and crime in the surrounding areas.

Unfortunately, this government has been gravely misled on these assumptions.

FRAUDULENT EVIDENCE ON DRUG INJECTION SITES

Over 30 peer reviewed studies have supposedly indicated that InSite, the drug injection site in Vancouver, has curtailed crime, disease, and led to a 35% reduction in deaths caused by drug overdose.

It is significant that these 30 studies of InSite were all carried out by the same individuals from the British Columbia Centre for Excellence on HIV/AIDS, located at UBC, who were the activists who had lobbied for the establishment of the drug injection site in the first place. As a result, they had a personal interest, as well as a conflict of interest,

in ensuring that InSite be recognized as successful. In effect, their research was carried out for the purpose of supporting the political objective of continuing the operation of InSite.

According to information obtained under the *Access to Information Act*, between 2003 and 2011, these very same researchers on InSite who had previously lobbied for the injection site, received over \$18 million from the Canadian Institute of Health Research (CIHR) to carry out their research. Their studies were peer reviewed only by supporters of the drug injection facility. Also, these researchers, contrary to standard scientific procedure, refused to share their data with other researchers so that their studies could be replicated. One of these studies on InSite was published in the British medical Journal, *Lancet* on April 18, 2011. This study was pivotal in the decision by the Supreme Court of Canada, handed down on September 30, 2011, to prevent the federal Minister of Health from closing down the injection site.

According to this 2011 study, there was supposedly a 35% reduction in overdoses in the 500 metre radius around InSite, while in the rest of Vancouver, the rate decreased by 9% due to the presence of InSite.

However, an international team, consisting of three Australian medical doctors, (including an epidemiologist and two addiction medicine specialists), a Canadian academic and an American psychiatrist, found serious errors in the advocates' studies, which invalidated their findings. Their objections to the InSite research was published in *Lancet*, British Medical Journal, January 14, 2012, Vol. 379.

In fact, a B.C. Coroner's report showed that overdoses actually increased in the InSite area by 14%, or 11% when population-adjusted, between 2003, the year before InSite opened, and 2005, the final year of the study period.

DRUG INJECTION SITES INCREASE CRIME RATE

Minister Philpott stated at page 17 of her testimony "There is already lots of evidence that these drug injection sites do not increase crime rates".

On the contrary, according to The Expert Advisory Committee on Drug Injection Sites, in its report released March 31st, 2008, the crime rate does increase in areas surrounding the drug injection sites because each addict causes \$350,000 worth of crime each year in order to purchase drugs from a trafficker to feed his/her addiction.

CRIME OCCURRING IN THE VICINITY OF THE INSITE AREA

The reality is that crime is such a problem in the area surrounding InSite that according to Inspector, John McKay, responsible for policing InSite, 65 officers from the Vancouver Police Department patrol the five-block area around InSite, in order to control the crime. The police officers are prohibited from charging addicts with possession and, instead, are obliged to escort the addict into the injection site. Drug addicts obtain their illicit drugs, of questionable purity, from drug traffickers located in the area, and the addicts bring these into the site for injection purposes. As a result, the drug injection site becomes a "honey pot" or meeting

point for drug traffickers.

Toronto Police Chief Mark Saunders (Toronto Sun April 2nd, 2017) has expressed concern about the enormous resources that will be required once Toronto's proposed three supervised injection sites are opened at the end of 2017.

COMMITTEE MAKES AN AMENDMENT TO BILL C-37

The Senate Legal and Constitutional Affairs Committee recommended in its report dated April 13, 2017, an amendment to Bill C-37 believing that drug injection sites can control the crime rate, by requiring a person using the site be provided with an "alternative pharmaceutical therapy". This proposed "alternative pharmaceutical therapy" includes the drugs suboxone, methadone, and heroin, which use by the addicts simply substitutes one addictive drug for another.

The prescribing of heroine for the addicts at a drug injection site, poses a risk to the addict in that there are no studies to support such use. Moreover, the prescribing of heroine deepens the addicts' addiction since higher dosages are required over time. This eventually leads to the addicts' inevitable early and often terrifying death. This amendment would, in effect, abandon the addict to his addiction, rather than restoring him to health.

THE ANSWER TO ADDICTION

The real answer to addiction is to provide treatment. Bill C-37 ignores the fact that addicts can be assisted in receiving proper treatment by way of the criminal justice system which is the major engine that gets addicts into treatment and recovery.

Research carried out at the University of Glasgow, Scotland and the Centre of Drug Research in Glasgow, Scotland, indicate that treatment of drug addicts increases when drug enforcement occurs. That is, positive results flow from drug enforcement in that one of the aftermaths of police operations is that there is a marked increase in the proportion of drug users seeking treatment. This is because drug courts allow the conviction to be suspended if the offender agrees to take treatment and be monitored through regular urinalysis and counselling. Those who complete the drug-free program receive a suspended sentence or conditional discharge. Those who fail, are required to return to the regular court system for sentencing. When offered a choice between a drug conviction or treatment, the addict chooses treatment.

It is significant that there is no difference in outcome between those addicts who seek treatment voluntarily or by way of the courts.

The real question to be addressed is whether addicts should be encouraged to continue their debilitating addiction by way of drug injection sites offering or permitting drugs to be injected, or given positive help by way of treatment to return to a healthy and normal life.

A compassionate society should not kill addicts by furthering and encouraging their addiction which is the result of the implementation of Bill C-37. Rather, society should reach out to addicts by way of providing them with treatment and eventual recovery to return to their normal lives. †

CONFUSION BY THE “EXPERTS” ON THE TRANSGENDERED ISSUE

It seems that the “experts” are all confused about the transgender issue. Either that, or they have tripped all over themselves in trying to promote it.

Everybody knows that children are not miniature adults. Their cognitive immaturity during adolescence has always been recognized. This is why society has long had age restrictions in place for children not only for consenting to medical procedures, but also for driving, voting, joining the military, and purchasing alcohol and cigarettes.

Yet the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) published an excerpt of a recent study published in the April, 2017 issue of *Experimental Psychology*. The study reported that children under the age of fourteen years of age are not cognitively capable of crossing a busy street “because children lack the perceptual judgment and physical skills needed to consistently get across safely”. The study said that this was the case for children aged 6, 8, 10 and 12. Only by the time the children reach 14 years of age, should they be deemed competent to cross a busy street.

What is so confusing, is that the AAP also deems children cognitively competent to decide that they are the wrong sex. AAP believes that they are capable of consent-

ing to puberty blockers, toxic sex hormones, and mutilating sex reassignment surgery. In fact, Benard P. Dreyer, the AAP President claims that “there appears to be no harm—and possible benefit—from parent-supported early social transitions” for children as young as three or four.

In its enthusiasm to promote transgenderism in children, the AAP has discreetly ignored a study titled: [*The landscape of sex-differential transcriptome and its consequent selection in human adults*](#)—published in BMC Biology earlier this year.

The study mapped out thousands of genes—the biological databases of all the information that makes every person unique—from 53 tissues that are similar in males and females, such as the skin, muscle, and brain. The study uncovered 1,559 genetic differences between males and females that relate not only to the sexual organs, but surprisingly to other organs such as the brain, skin, and heart.

These findings suggest that there is much more involved in the notion of changing one’s gender to the opposite sex than simply surgery and hormonal treatment.

This all seems to have created confusion in the minds of the AAP. Being politically correct obviously has created problems for the experts. †

THE GOOD NEWS FILE

Despite what you are told by the mainstream media (MSM) there is much good news to report on the culture wars. Many individuals, both in North America and around the world, are ignoring the left’s propaganda, and are, instead, showing a remarkable resistance to it.

We can’t begin to provide you with a comprehensive report on the positive developments in the culture wars world-wide because they are so extensive. We can, however, provide a few examples of this resistance which have gone unreported. The MSM either deliberately ignore it or misreport this news in order to give the impression that the left has won the culture wars. It has not.

Some of these positive stories include:

I. ABORTION

(i) Abortions has hit a record low in the United States.

The pro-abortion research group, the Alan Guttmacher Institute in New York, states that abortions in the U.S. decreased 14% between 2011 and 2014. These are the lowest numbers since 1975, two years after the US Supreme Court brought in abortion on demand in *Roe v. Wade*.

The decline has been accurately attributed to state laws passed in recent years, such as:

- Sixteen US states ban abortions performed on the unborn child when it can feel pain.
- The Alabama Supreme Court unanimously recognized

the personhood of unborn children.

- Alabama is the seventh state to allow wrongful-death-actions before the pre-born child becomes viable.
 - Oklahoma requires restroom signs to help women find abortion alternatives. This applies to hospitals, nursing homes, restaurants and public schools.
 - Iowa has approved a bill to allow women to sue the abortionist for emotional grief after abortion.
 - Arkansas passed a law in January, 2017 making it a crime to perform a dismemberment abortion for any other reason than to save a mother’s life. In 2015 Arkansas passed a law banning “web-cam” abortions, whereby doctors prescribe abortion pills by phone or video conference, without the patient being present. Five other states have also banned web-cam abortions.
 - Minnesota passed a law banning the funding of abortions.
 - Missouri passed a law stopping the sale of the body parts of aborted babies.
 - Indiana passed laws protecting parental rights stopping secret abortions on teenagers.
- (ii) Paraguay passed a law upholding the right to life of human beings from conception to natural death. President Cartes of Paraguay stated he would not bow before the pressure of international agencies (the UN) to undermine the rights of the unborn and the family.

- (iii) 76% of the abortion clinics that were operating in the US in 1991 have closed. In 1991 there were 2,176 surgical abortion facilities in the US. Today there are 517.
- (iv) The abortion rate in the nation of Georgia has diminished by 50% from 2005 to 2010. The Georgian government encouraged births by giving parents of a third child a subsidy of \$600 and one of \$1,200 for a fourth child.
- (v) Abortions in Italy hit the lowest point in 2015 since the country legalized the procedure almost 40 years ago. There was a 9.3% drop in abortions from 2014 which was a continuation of a decade long decline.
- (vi) In January 2017 more than 50,000 individuals across France gathered for the March for Life in Paris. This March for Life is the largest pro-life demonstration in Europe.
- (vii) March for Life in Berlin, Germany drew the largest crowd yet in September, 2016. The march was organized by 13 pro-life groups in Germany. These marches began in 2008, with growing numbers of participants each year.
- (viii) The US House of Representatives voted 238 to 183 to end domestic taxpayer funding for abortions by all federal departments, agencies and programs

II. SAME-SEX MARRIAGE

- (i) Mexican President, Enrique Peña Nieto removed legislation to amend the constitution to create homosexual marriage after months of repeated massive marches of hundreds of thousands of Mexicans flocking to pro-family demonstrations. This led to a massive electoral loss for the President's ruling party in June, 2016.
- (ii) In December, 2013, a South Korean Appeals Court rejected same-sex marriage.
- (iii) Tens of thousands of people marched in Paris in October, 2016 to call for the repeal of a law allowing homosexual marriage.
- (iv) The legislature in South Australia defeated same-sex marriage.
- (v) A three million signature petition against same-sex marriage in Romania has led to a proposed amendment to the Constitution.
- (vi) Poland is one of seven countries in the EU whose constitution bans same-sex marriage and the Polish President Andrzej Duda announced on, January 25, 2017, that Poland's constitution would not be changed.

III. EUTHANASIA

- (i) Euthanasia was prohibited in the US state of Ohio and in South Africa.
- (ii) The Australia Medical Association (AMA) released a statement in 2016 that doctors should not be involved in euthanasia, and called for greater investment in palliative care.

IV. PORNOGRAPHY

- (i) The House of Commons in Canada unanimously voted, in December, 2016 to direct the Health Committee to ex-

amine the public health effects on children, women and men, of the ease of access to and viewing online of violent and degrading sexually explicit material. The study will commence in February, 2017 and will be completed by the summer of 2017.

- (ii) The US publication "Cosmopolitan", which includes sexually explicit articles, was banned from a supermarket chain's check-out lanes. This decision was made by Marsh Supermarkets—a chain of produce markets and convenience stores with 72 locations in Indiana and Ohio.
- (iii) The Hilton Worldwide Hyatt Hotels, Intercontinental Hotels Group (IHG), and Starwood Hotels no longer offer on-demand, hard-core pornography to guests.

V. NEW MEDICAL TECHNOLOGIES

- (i) The European Parliament, claiming that surrogacy is "exploitation of the female body and reproductive organs" invoked a ban in 2015 against surrogacy.
- (ii) In October, 2016 the forty-seven member Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE) rejected (for the third time) legalizing surrogacy throughout Europe. 110,000 citizens in Europe signed a petition requesting that PACE condemn all forms of surrogacy as being against the best interests of children.

VI. FREEDOM OF RELIGION

- (i) The State of Massachusetts' anti-discrimination law which provides for public "accommodation" for homosexuals, lesbians and the transgendered, was declared by the State Human Rights Commission as not applicable to religious institutions.

VII. OTHER GOOD NEWS ITEMS

- (i) In India, its Supreme Court has ordered the closure of all sterilization camps as well as compensation to women and their families for such procedures.
- (ii) The Congress in Chile has killed a proposed measure mandating the distribution in all the nation's schools of a sex education book that advocates gender ideology and contains a graphic description of perverse sexual acts.

VIII. PLANNED PARENTHOOD

- (i) The Tex Mex style restaurant, "Chili's", had been donating 15% of its receipts to Planned Parenthood. Because of backlash, this arrangement has been discontinued.
- (ii) Macy's Department Store has been a corporate contributor to Planned Parenthood. It has now ended its relationship with Planned Parenthood and will no longer donate to it. Macy's joins AT&T, Coca-Cola, Ford and Xerox in publicly distancing themselves from Planned Parenthood.
- (iii) The Iowa State Legislature passed a bill, by a 30-to-20 vote, denying funding for abortions provided by Planned Parenthood and other clinics that facilitate the termination of unborn life. †
